The Dentsply Sirona Global Clinical Case Contest 2024-2025

The contest is executed in 2 stages:
National & Regional Contests and the Global Final in Germany.

National & Regional Contests

until May 15, 2025

- Selection of national/regional winners per category (direct and indirect).
- For a national or regional final per category to be held, at least 3 clinical cases per category must be submitted.
- If the region or country does not have a minimum number of cases for each category, (direct and indirect), the cases may be combined into a single category for judging and the 1st place winner of the combined category advances to stage 2, the Global Final.
- 1st place winners in each category from each participating region/nation enter the Global Final.
- One winner per nation or region per category, respectively.
- One case per student, either direct or indirect category.
- Winners will receive a prize, which varies from country to country.
- The national/regional winners per category are qualified for the Global Final.



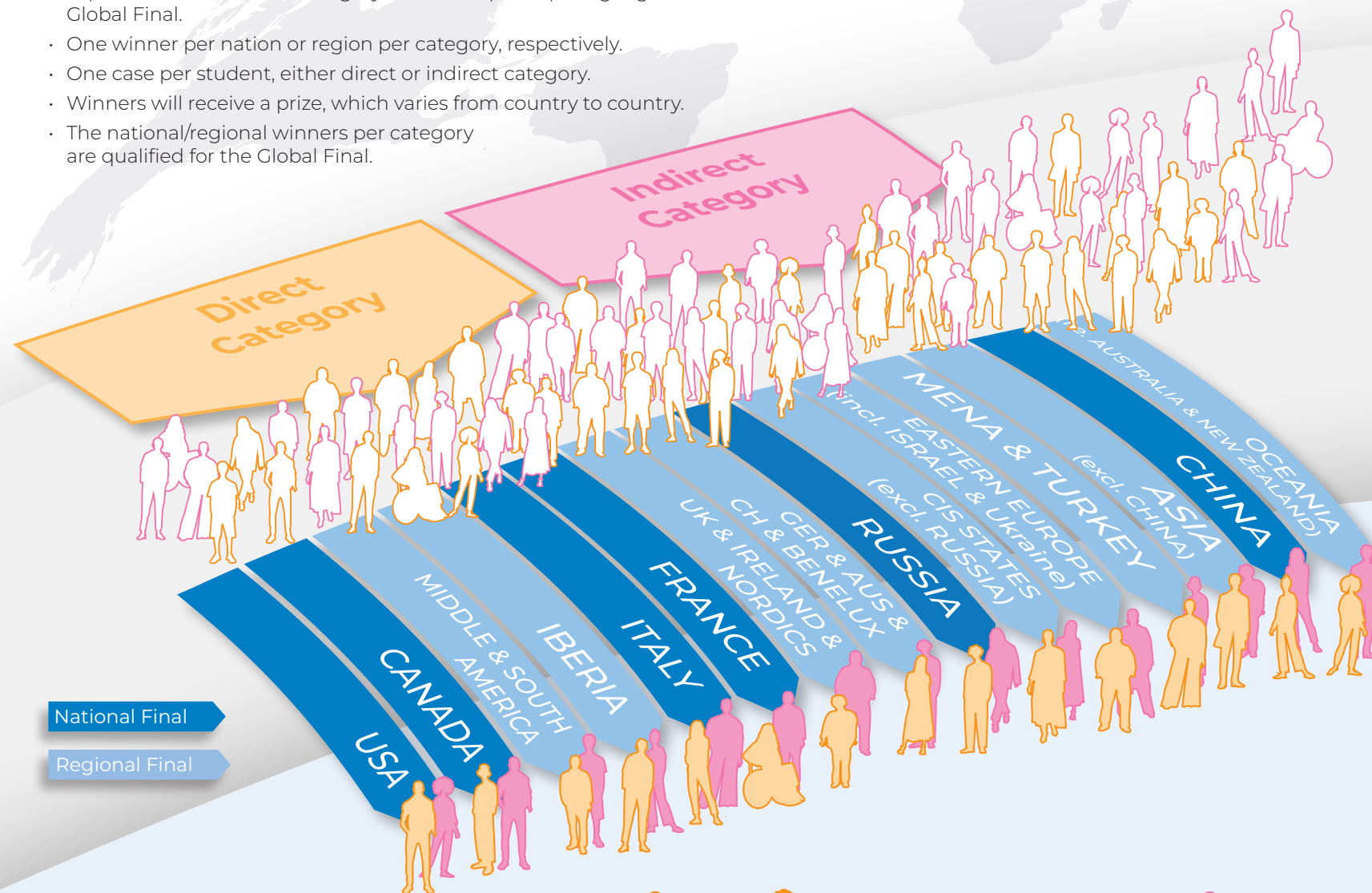
The Dentsply Sirona Global Clinical Case Contest (GCCC) is a worldwide competition for dental students to showcase clinical restorations produced in direct fashion or indirectly created using the chairside CAD/CAM workflow and the Dentsply Sirona restorative portfolio. With the 2024-2025 edition we will be celebrating the 20th anniversary with you.

Since its inception in 2004, more than 6,500 dental students have participated, with the 2023-2024 competition drawing close to 415 cases and 130 dental schools. Patient cases are photo-documented, accompanied by English descriptions, and submitted in a standardized format.

Participants must be dental students enrolled in a college or university at the time of entering the contest (repeated participation excluded).

Competition in two categories is now possible: direct and indirect restorations. The participant chooses a category, either direct or indirect. For a national or regional final per category to be held, at least 3 clinical cases per category must be submitted.

A university should designate a tutor for its participants. A tutor can range from a dental faculty member to a post-graduate student. Their purpose will be to oversee the student's clinical case.



Global Final in Constance/Germany

on July 2, 2025

- The national/regional winners per category will present their cases to a top-class international panel of judges at the global judging event.
- The top three contestants per category will be presented with an award.
- The national/regional winners per category with their tutors are invited.



Clinical Cases and Materials Used

Clinical anterior or posterior restorations are placed using the entire Dentsply Sirona restorative product line. All entries must be submitted electronically, photo documented and accompanied by text, and submitted in a standardized format provided by Dentsply Sirona. All Dentsply Sirona products, required for fabricating cases, are available free of charge to participants. Direct as well as indirect restorations created chairside using the CAD/CAM workflow are eligible for entering the contest. It is allowed to treat several teeth.
